SANITIZING SPRAY

Preparation & Usage

GCNA is transitioning from SteriFab to BAC STOP 3A as our product sanitizing spray.

BAC STOP 3A is an Antiseptic Hand Sanitizer in a liquid form. Mixed with water, it becomes an effective sanitizing spray that works comparably to SteriFab.

PREPARATION

- 1. Apply gloves and protective eyewear.
- 2. Pour one part BAC STOP 3A to one part water in a spray bottle (50/50 mix).
- 3. Seal spray bottle and shake well to mix.
- 4. Label each bottle: "Sanitizing Spray".

USAGE

- 1. Set nozzle to mist and spray donations. Do not wipe or rub in.
- 2. Allow treated donations to rest for 10 minutes.
- 3. Process normally.

Store in a cool, well-ventilated place away from flammable items.

CAUTIONS:

- Ensure the spray bottle intended for BAC STOP 3A is rinsed well and contains no unknown chemicals.
- Severely eye irritant: wear protective eyewear to protect against splashes.
 In case of contact with eye, remove contact lenses (if applicable) and use eye wash station for several minutes.
