Disinfecting Donations with Steri-Fab Spray

Important General Information:

- The Steri-Fab spray must be used on all donations as they arrive at the donation door.
- *Label spray bottles **Steri-Fab** to ensure no cross contamination with other cleaning chemicals occurs.
- 2 bottles of Steri-Fab spray must be kept at the Donation Attendant workstation at all times. Check to make sure there are 2 full spray bottles available at the beginning of each day and each shift. See picture on right for workstation setup.
- Make sure the spray bottle with the Steri-Fab spray is set for mist and not direct stream for better coverage across donations.



*Safety requirements:

•

- Remember to wear gloves.
- Remember to wear goggles when filling and refilling bottles.
 - Steri-Fab is FLAMMABLE. Only store in a dry, well ventilated area away from any heat source.
 - DO NOT SMOKE while using Steri-Fab.

Follow the directions below to disinfect donations:

1. * Unload the donations from the vehicle as you normally would and provide the donor with a tax-deductible receipt. Place donations in the appropriate gaylord (follow 80/20 rule).

2. There is no need to remove the donations from a bag or box. Once you mark the donation on the Daily Donor Log, spray one to two pumps of the Steri-Fab over the donations in the gaylord as shown in the picture. Repeat for all donations as they are received.

- 3. Allow items to dry at minimum 10 minutes before processing.
- 4. When finished, return the spray bottle to the workstation.
