activities for your next team gathering!

Four CORNERS

GOAL / OBJECTIVE:

To learn more about team members, their interests, and commonalities.

GROUP SIZE: 3-20

TIME: 20-30 minutes.

EQUIPMENT: One Sharpie marker and one sheet of blank paper per team member
(Optional: colored markers)

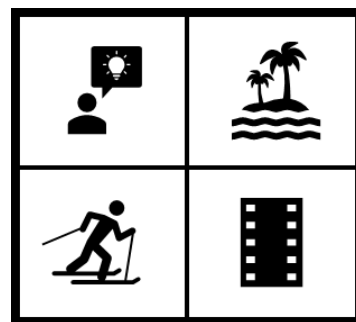
RULES:

Give each team member a sheet of paper and a marker. Next, have them draw two lines on their paper to create 4 corners (see picture to the right).

Label each corner with 1, 2, 3, and 4.

- Corner 1: Draw the most influential person in your life.
- Corner 2: Draw your dream vacation if money was not a concern.
- Corner 3: Draw an unusual/interesting hobby you have.
- Corner 4: Draw a TV or movie character you most relate to.

**Participants should only draw pictures, with no writing or words.*



When all team members finish, or when the time is up, have each person show the group their paper and talk through their answers. If a team member is quiet, ask a couple of follow-up questions to encourage them to share more details. This activity is about sharing who our team members are as people outside of work, what is important to them, and their aspirations.

DISCUSSION/DEBRIEF:

- What did you learn about your teammates today? Did anything surprise you?
- Do you think teams work better together when they know each other as people? Why or why not?

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
