## Line 'EM UP

## **GOAL / OBJECTIVE:**

A quick ice breaker activity to help your team learn more about each other.

GROUP SIZE: 5+ TIME: 10 minutes

EQUIPMENT: Masking tape or rope (approximately 20' long)

## **DIRECTIONS:**

To prepare, lay down a straight line of masking tape or a rope approximately 20 feet long. Tell each team they will line up shoulder-to-shoulder based on their responses. You will ask questions that prompt a numerical response from largest to smallest.

For example, if the prompt is "Distance from home to work", each team member will line up in order from the farthest to the shortest distance. To add a fun challenge, require all (or some) team members to remain silent.

## **OPTIONAL PROMPTS:**

- Birthdays?
- Number of countries visited?
- Number of streaming services you subscribe to?
- How spicy do you like your food?
- Most common, to most unusual middle name?
- How long it takes for you to get ready in the morning?
- How comfortable you are with public speaking?
- How long have you worked for Goodwill?
- How many pets do you have?
- How many children do you have?
