TEAMBUILDER
activities for your next team gathering!

SALT *and* PEPPER

GOAL / OBJECTIVE:

A fun, light game that helps team members learn more about each other while emphasizing teamwork and communication.

GROUP SIZE: 6 - 40

TIME: 10 minutes

EQUIPMENT:

- A few rolls of tape
- Markers
- Strips of paper with matching paired items written on them; cut separately - one for each participant

SETUP:

Determine how many team members will be participating (it will need to be an even number). Then create a list of items that pairs (such as salt and pepper, sun and moon, peanut butter and jelly). Cut them into individual items and tape a single word on each team member's back. Make certain they don't see their own word!

DIRECTIONS:

"When I say go, circulate among each other. Asking only 'yes' or 'no' questions, try to determine the word you have taped to your back. Once you know your word, confirm it by trying to find your mate in the room. Once you've found each other, raise your hands. First pair to identify each other wins."

DISCUSSION / DEBRIEF:

- How did you find out the word on your back?
- What types of communication helped? What held you back?
- What skills helped you locate your partner as quickly as possible?
